	One letter of recommendation from a teacher, school official, or academic mentor. Your letter of recommendation must be dated <u>no earlier than February 1, 2024</u> . You may also include additional letters of recommendation from other persons who are familiar with your goals. All recommendation letters must be in a sealed envelope signed by the originator on the outside flap along the seam as shown.

	 OFFICIAL copy of high school transcript(s) or college transcript(s) Unofficial transcripts & online grades will NOT be accepted. Please keep in mind that it matake the academic office 1-3 weeks to fulfill your official transcript request. You should contact the registrar's office with ample time to ensure that Gain FCU receives your official transcripts by the deadline. If you are entering your first year at a college, university, or technical school, you may provide your high school transcripts. All other participants must submit their college transcripts.

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Application Information and Regulations

Established in 1940, formerly known as Burbank City Employees Federal Credit Union was formed by a group of City workers who joined together by pooling their money to create their own special organization for saving and borrowing. As a Not-For-Profit financial institution, we have acknowledged the need for financial literacy in the community. In 1996 we established our Independent Advantage program for teens, to teach life skills and financial literacy not often taught or discussed in schools. Our program is still going strong and only growing in the Burbank and San Fernando Valley. In 2022 the Gaining Ground Scholarship program was designed to give a financial advantage to help accomplish academic goals.

Eligibility

To be considered for the Gaining Ground Scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a senior, or first year college student
- First time High School applicants must be a senior from high school and be scheduled to graduate by June 30, 2024
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- Must be going to college/university/technical school at least "part-time" (equivalent to 6 units or more)
- Must be planning to attend a
 - 4-year college or university, or
 - o 2-year community college, or
 - o An accredited vocational or technical school

Eligibility for Independent Advantage Students

- o Must be a senior, or first year college student
- o First time High School applicants must be a senior from high school and be scheduled to graduate by June 30, 2024
- o Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- o Must be going to college/university/technical school at least "part-time" (equivalent to 6 units or more)
- o Must be planning to attend a
 - 4-year college or university, or
 - 2-year community college, or
 - An accredited vocational or technical school

Regulations

- If awarded, the Scholarship is payable in the following manner:
 - Checks can be made payable to your educational institution
 - Checks can be made payable directly to the award winner for reimbursement purposes only. Original itemized receipts must be provided to our office in order to be compensated for these eligible reimbursable educational expenses: tuition, books, campus fees, student parking, school supplies, laptops, etc.
- The scholarship award must be used by December 1, 2024. After the deadline, any unused funds will be returned to Gain FCU. Funds awarded can be deferred to a planned future date on a case-by-case basis.
- Prior scholarship award applicants/recipients are eligible to apply for the scholarship again if the scholarship eligibility is met. Awards can be issued to the same person maximum of (2) times.
